
I Should Already Know

- 1 The Equator is an invisible line that runs around the centre of the Earth.
 - 2 The North and South Poles are the places furthest away from the Equator.
 - 3 A place is usually hot if it is near the Equator.
 - 4 A place is usually cold if it is near the North or South Pole.
 - 5 Rainforests and deserts are near the equator.
- The north/south poles are furthest away from the equator and are the coldest places on earth.

rainforest	An evergreen, dense area of forest mostly in tropical areas; rains all year long
adapt	To change
habitat	A natural place for a plant or animal.
iceberg	A large floating mass of ice that has broken from a glacier.
desert	A very dry, sandy area with few or no plants growing in it.
equator	the imaginary circle around the earth that is halfway between the North and South Poles.
