Vocabulary

Jewish people: People who follow the Jewish Faith.

Festival: A day of celebration.

Remembering: Having an awareness of the past.

Rosh Hashanah: Rosh Hashanah is the Jewish New Year festival and commemorates the creation of the world

Yom Kippur: Yom Kippur, is the most sacred and solemn day of the Jewish year.

Sukkot: Sukkot celebrates the years that the Jews spent in the desert on their way to the Promised Land, and celebrates the way in which [God](#) protected them under difficult desert conditions.

Hannukah: Hanukkah or Chanukah is the Jewish Festival of Lights.

Hanukkiah: A candelabrum which has nine branches that is lit during the festival of Hanukkah.
