## English

For the first part of this term, the children will read and analyse the text 'Oliver and the Seawigs' by Philp Reeve and Sarah McIntyre. Within this unit, we will write diary entries and a narrative that creates suspense for the reader.

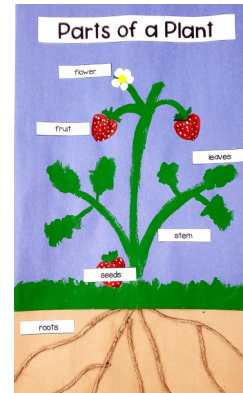
Within the second half of the term, Year 3 will read, analyse and discuss the text 'Leon and the Place Between' by 'Angela McAllister'. Children will create their own fantasy story.



## Science

This term, Year 3 will be studying Rocks, Soils and Fossils. They will identify properties of different rock types, how soil is formed and the fossilisation process.

Children will also look at Lights and Shadows in Autumn 2.



## Computing

This term we are looking at Creating Media in the form of stop-frame animation. Children will capture and edit images to produce a stop-frame animation that tells a story.

We will also look at how computers can be connected to make networks.



## Maths

Throughout the term the children will be developing their understanding of the following key skills and concepts:

Number and Place Value  
Addition and Subtraction  
Multiplication and Division.

Later in the term children will learn and be tested on their times tables.



## Topic

### **History**

We will look at Britain during the Stone Age, through the Bronze Age and into the Iron Age. We will be trying to answer the question **What were the most significant changes during this time for people living in Britain?**

### **Geography**

This term children will learn about rivers. We will look at the key features of rivers, how they are used, their journey from source to mouth and how people have changed rivers.



## Art and Design & Technology

**D&T:** Children will learn, understand and apply the principles of a healthy and varied diet.

They will have opportunities to prepare food, measure ingredients, assemble and follow a recipe.



**Art:** Children will learn about how and why art was created thousands of years ago, using homemade paints from natural materials and replicating painting techniques from the past.
