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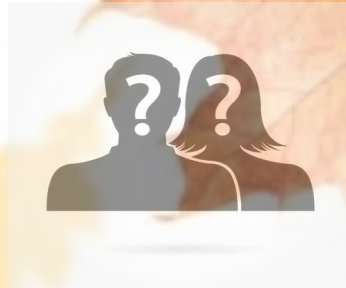

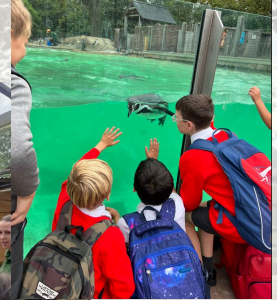

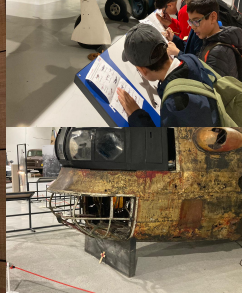

The girl that found admiration in Autumn

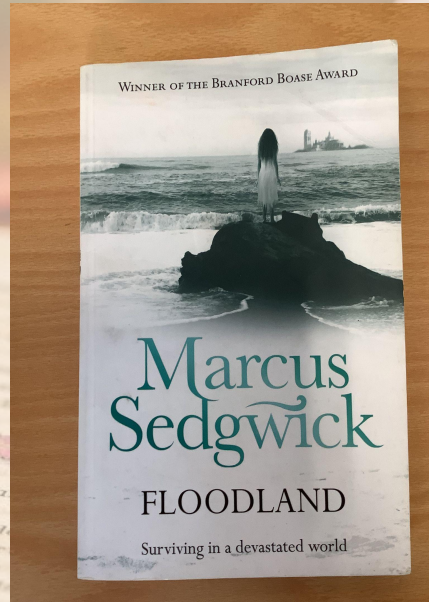

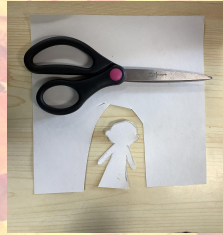
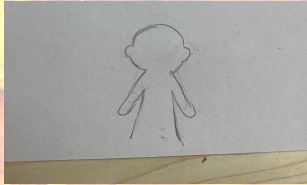
I would recommend this book to children aged 9-11.
