## Welcome to the Summer Term

The Extra Club welcomed all our children back for the Summer Term. Always a joy to think that we have lighter, brighter and warmer evenings to enjoy together. It is that wonderful time of year when we are out making the most of the weather with picnics, games and outdoor play with friends from all year groups.

At the end of the Spring Term the Extra Club purchased some new equipment for the rooms including a pool table, magnetic dart board, table football, a wooden kitchen, café and shop, new dolls and construction toys.

During the height of Covid, our rooms were bubbled as best we could, for both children and staff. Although this is much freer now, we are still tending to register our children in age groups for practical reasons.

We are running half termly competitions in addition to our regular drawing competitions. This is where myself, Miss Hatton and our student staff watch and listen closely to the children. Last term we focussed on 'Manners'. The children who were recognised by staff for displaying impeccable manners were Isabela Di Pino Biggs, Lara Coles, Teddy Hale and Vheer Vaswani. This half term we will be looking for children consistently showing 'Kindness'.

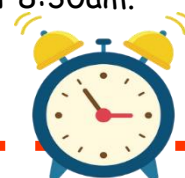
## Places

## Timings

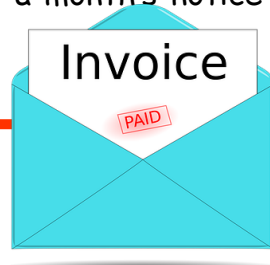
