White Shirt With long or short sleeves.	Any retailer selling school uniform.	
School Tie	Our school shop only.	Ties may be put on elastic, particularly in Reception and KS1, to aid pupils in dressing independently.
Grey Skirts/Tunics/Culottes/Trousers	Any retailer selling school uniform.	Please note that we do not allow combat style, pull on/stretch material style or, skinny fit culottes or trousers.
Red Jumper or Cardigan with the School Logo	Our school shop only.	
Socks Short or long plain white or grey socks.	Any retailer selling school uniform.	
Tights Plain grey or pillar box red.	Any retailer selling school uniform.	
Shoes Plain black or red leather-type shoes with a maximum heel measurement of 2.5cm. We do not allow trainers or other types of fashion boots/shoes such as Kickers. Shoes must not enclose the ankle.	Any retailer selling school uniform.	Black leather-type ankle boots may be worn under trousers only.
Hat Any colour beanie style woollen hat in winter and any colour baseball cap or sun hat in summer.	Any retailer.	
Coats In winter, a warm outdoor coat which should also be waterproof and have a hood. In summer, a lightweight outdoor coat which should also be waterproof and have a hood.	Any retailer.	Coats can be any colour.

<p>(Summer term until October half term only)</p> <p>Dress or Playsuit Pale pink and white gingham.</p>	<p>Any retailer selling school uniform.</p>	<p>During the summer term and until October half term, girls may choose to wear a pale pink and white gingham dress or playsuit. They may wear white cycling shorts under the dress if they wish. The dress or playsuit must be worn with white socks.</p> <p>All girls, not just those in Y5 and Y6, may wear white short sleeved shirts, with our school tie and grey skirts/culottes/tunic/trousers during the summer term until October half term.</p>

Yellow short sleeved polo shirt	Any retailer selling school uniform.	There is no school logo on the t-shirt.
Black shorts	Any retailer selling school uniform.	Shorts should be the following style: 
Black Tracksuit with White Piping and the School Logo	Our school shop only.	There is only one style of tracksuit for all pupils from Reception to Y6.
Plain Red PE Bags <i>Red drawstring bag without the school logo.</i>	Any retailer.	

Please note that any kits required for interschool competitions will be provided by the school.

Red Book Bag with School Logo For pupils in Rec to Y2	Our school shop only.	
Rucksack For pupils in KS2	Any retailer.	
Water Bottle	Any retailer.	Pupils should have a water bottle in school. It does not have to have the school logo.
Hairbands Should be plain and coloured white or red in winter, plain pink or yellow and gingham hairbands or ribbons with summer dresses.	Any retailer.	All hairbands and ribbons should simply serve to ensure hair is tidy and not serve as fashion items. Painted nails, make-up and other hair adornments are not allowed in school.
Watches, which do not connect to the internet , may be worn by KS2 children at their own risk.	Any retailer.	
Jewellery Earrings - A simple single stud (gold or silver) in each ear may be worn.		Rings, bracelets, necklaces, earrings and other jewellery may not be worn in school, except a simple single stud (gold or silver) in each ear. Single piercings are not allowed. These must be covered with tape before leaving home on PE and games days.
