The school colours are red and gold and all children are expected to wear school uniform as a condition of entry to the school.

<b>White shirt</b> With long or short sleeves.	Any retailer selling school uniform.	
<b>School tie</b>	Our school shop only.	Ties may be put on elastic, particularly in Reception and KS1, to aid pupils in dressing independently.  <i>The school may relax the wearing of a tie, particularly during hot weather.</i>
<b>Grey skirt, tunic, culottes, trousers or shorts</b>	Any retailer selling school uniform.	Trousers and shorts should be straight legged without combat style utility pockets on the legs. Please note that combat style, jogging bottom, pull on/stretch material style or skinny fit culottes, trousers or shorts are not permitted.
<b>Red jumper or cardigan with the school logo</b>	Our school shop only.	
<b>Socks or tights</b> Ankle or knee length plain white or grey socks or plain grey or pillar box red tights.	Any retailer selling school uniform.	
<b>Shoes</b> Plain, flat black or red leather-type shoes (not trainers) with a maximum heel measurement of 2.5cm. Shoes <b>must not</b> enclose the ankle.	Any retailer selling school uniform.	Plain, flat black leather-type ankle boots may be worn under trousers only.
<b>Hat</b> In winter, a bean style woollen hat of any colour.  In summer, a baseball cap or sun hat in any colour.	Any retailer.	

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<p><b>Coats</b> In winter, a warm, waterproof outdoor coat with a hood.</p> <p>In summer, a lightweight, waterproof outdoor coat with a hood.</p>	<p>Any retailer.</p>	<p>Coats can be any colour.</p>
<p><b>(Summer term (after Easter) until October half term only)</b></p> <p><b>Pale pink and white gingham dress or playsuit</b></p>	<p>Any retailer selling school uniform.</p>	<p>During the summer term (after Easter) and until October half term, a pale pink and white gingham dress or playsuit may be worn with white socks. White cycling shorts may be worn under the dress.</p>

<p><b>Yellow short sleeved polo shirt.</b></p> <p><b>Black thermal long sleeved top can be worn when cold.</b></p>	<p>Any retailer selling school uniform.</p>	<p>There is no school logo on the polo shirt.</p>
<p><b>Black shorts</b></p>	<p>Any retailer selling school uniform.</p>	<p>Shorts should be the following style:</p> 
<p><b>Black tracksuit with white piping and the school logo</b></p>	<p>Our school shop only.</p>	<p>There is only one style of tracksuit for all pupils from Reception to Y6.</p>
<p><b>Plain red drawstring PE bag without the school logo</b></p>	<p>Any retailer.</p>

<p><b>Water bottle</b></p>	<p>Any retailer.</p>	<p>Pupils should have a water bottle in school. It does not have to have the school logo.</p>
<p><b>Hairbands and clips</b> All long hair should be tied back with a simple, plain hairband, ribbon or slide in school colours. <i>(Red,</i></p>	<p>Any retailer.</p>	<p>All hairbands and ribbons should simply serve to ensure hair is tidy and not serve as fashion items.</p>

Watches, <b>which do not connect to the internet</b> , may be worn by KS2 children at their own risk.	Any retailer.	
<b>Jewellery</b> Earrings - A simple single stud (gold or silver) can be worn in pierced ears.		Rings, bracelets, necklaces, earrings and other jewellery may <b>not</b> be worn in school  These must be covered with tape before leaving home on PE and games days.
