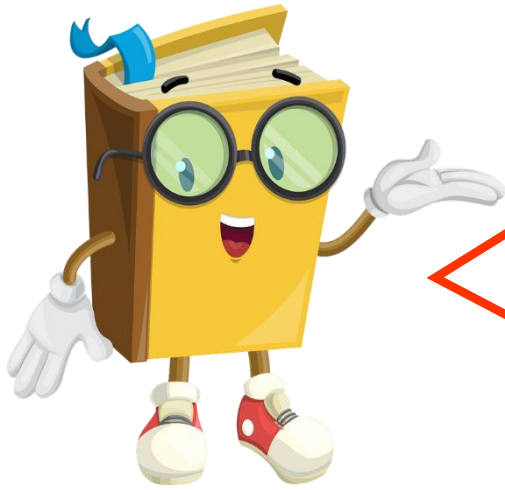


Summer Fete

School Trips

Year 1's trip to Walton on the Naze

Last week Year 2 went on an educational visit to Epping Forest Field Centre linking to their Science topic on plants. They also learnt about trees, how we can identify them and what they need to germinate.
